FAX CONSENT FORM

URGENT TPBA Members: Effective 25 August 2003, the Federal Communications Commission will no longer allow associations and businesses to fax any form of advertising without prior written consent, even to their own members. While TPBA is moving toward more email notifications, we still do not have email addresses for the majority of our members and there are occasions when the information must be faxed. Because "advertising" includes anything involving money such as notices about meetings, events, programs, and even dues or renewals, the practical impact of this ruling is that **you will stop receiving important information from TPBA unless you provide written consent.** Faxed information will resume after we receive your consent form. Rest assured that TPBA, along with NAHB and every other association in the country, is fighting this ruling, but from a legal perspective, the FCC has declined to reverse its opinion and believes that Congress must make the change. Of course that has not happen. Penalties for non-compliance include FCC fines and, more importantly, a private right of action and class action lawsuits. **Please complete the form and fax back to TPBA .**
